As a chaperone, you will be responsible for a group of 6 to 10 students during the week of their participation in our Broadway Intensive. You will stay in a room on the same floor as your students in our Times Square hotel with another chaperone, ensuring that your group has a safe and enjoyable experience while they are away from home.

Being an Open Jar Chaperone is a volunteer position. You will need to arrange your own transportation to and from New York City for the selected week. Your hotel accommodations will be provided by Open Jar, sharing a double room with another team member. We will also provide breakfast and dinner each day, and a ticket to each of the three Broadway shows so you can supervise your group. While the students are busy with their classes during the day (approximately 9:00 am to 4:00 pm), you will be free to explore the city and/or return to the hotel to relax, while still remaining on-call in case you are needed.

We are looking for chaperones who not only share the same passion and enthusiasm for the performing arts that our students do, but who are also able to remain focused on individual student needs, and to ensure student safety and comfort for the duration of their visit to New York. Our chaperones must be excellent communicators and problem solvers. They need to remain flexible throughout the day to help deal with any situations or changes that may occur. Open Jar Institute CHAPERONE GUIDELINES



- 1. Chaperones must take part in an orientation meeting on Zoom prior to the session where policies and emergency procedures are discussed. They must abide by said policies and procedures for the entire week.
- 2. All chaperones must be at least 21 years of age.
- 3. Chaperones will be responsible for their group of 6 to 10 students when they are not in class.
- 4. Chaperones are expected to be familiar with the *Open Jar Code of Conduct and Discipline* and shall report all suspected violations to the Program Director immediately.
- 5. Chaperones may not discipline students, staff, or another chaperone.
- 6. Drinking of alcoholic beverages or use of illegal drugs by a chaperone at any time is prohibited.
- 7. Chaperones must *actively* supervise and keep an accurate check of students assigned to them at all times.
- 8. Chaperones may not retire for the night until all their students are in their rooms, and the room has been secured. Chaperones are expected to remain onsite for the duration of the night and will respond to any student needs/emergencies during that time.
- 9. Chaperones are required to report any inappropriate student behavior, illness of students, or other significant issues to the Program Director immediately.
- 10. Chaperones may be asked at certain times to be responsible for students not listed in their group and should remain flexible during these times
- 11. Chaperones will be on duty from Noon on the first day of the session (Sunday) to Noon the following Saturday. They must arrange travel plans to fit that schedule.
